



# 1-2-3 Monkey FLIP!

A Jungle of Laughs in Every Game!

AGES 6+ | PLAYERS 2-6 | LEARNING TIME 5 min | PLAYING TIME 10-20 min

Deep in the heart of the Amazon, the legendary Golden Monkey cast a spell over all the fruits and monkeys of the jungle.

Now, everything is out of control. Fruits multiply, monkeys leap like crazy, and the sneakiest ones even team up with the Golden Monkey to keep you collecting fruits nonstop.

## GAME OBJECTIVE

Run out of all the cards in your hand.

## GAME SETUP

Shuffle all the Cards and Deal them Face Down evenly among all Players. Everyone must hold their cards face down all the time.

Leave space in the center of the table for the Discard Pile.



## HOW TO PLAY

The player to the left of the dealer goes first and the game continues clockwise. Players must play their cards at a fast, steady pace.

## JUNGLE SEQUENCE

On their turn, Players must quickly turn over the top card from their hand and place it FACE UP in the Discard Pile saying one part of the Jungle Sequence "1, 2, 3, MONKEY FLIP".



The next player says "2" and places one card on the Discard Pile.



The first player says "1" and places one card on the Discard Pile.



The next player says "MONKEY FLIP" and places one card on the Discard Pile.



After "MONKEY FLIP", the sequence starts again at "1" with the next player until it gets interrupted by a SLAP event.

## SLAP EVENT!

When two of the same fruits appear consecutively at any moment in the game, no matter which part of the Jungle Sequence they appear in, players must SLAP the Discard Pile.

The last player to Slap the Discard Pile takes all the cards from the Pile, puts them on the bottom of their cards, and they start again at "1".

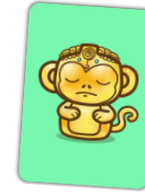


When "MONKEY FLIP" is being said and a Sneaky Monkey appears, players must SLAP the Discard Pile.



The last player to SLAP the Discard Pile takes all the cards and puts them on the bottom of their cards and they start the Jungle Sequence.

When the Golden Monkey appears at any time during the game, ALL Players must perform the Golden Monkey Ritual and then SLAP the Discard Pile.



And guess what? Yes, if they are last, they have to take all of the cards and add them to the bottom of their hand and the Jungle Sequence continues.

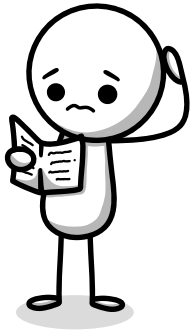
## GOLDEN MONKEY RITUAL

- Put one hand on your head and the other on the side of your belly. (See the graphic below.)
- Move your hands like a monkey.
- Make monkey sounds: "UHHHH, UHHHH, UHHHH"
- Finally, SLAP the Discard Pile.

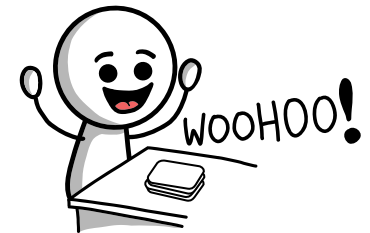

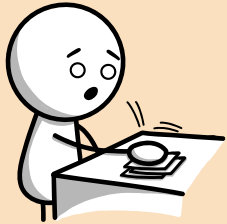
## WINNING THE GAME

The first player to run out of all their cards will be the Winner. (See Exception #1 in the Clarifying Doubts Section)



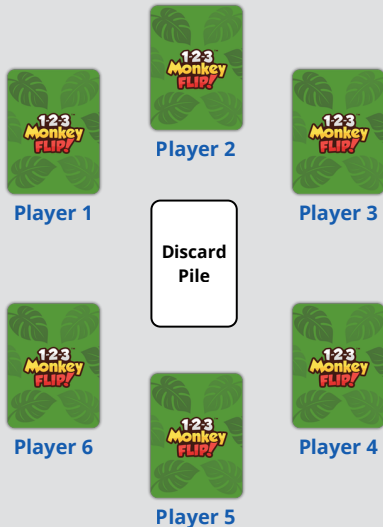
## MISTAKES AND PENALTIES

- When the Golden Monkey appears, if you SLAP the Discard Pile before doing the ritual, you may immediately perform the ritual and SLAP again. As long as you are not the last player to SLAP the Discard Pile, you do not have to take all the cards.
- When a player SLAPS the Discard Pile when there is no SLAP event, they must take all the cards from the pile.



- When a player says the wrong word during the Jungle Sequence ("1", "2", "3", "MONKEY FLIP") they must take all the cards from the pile.

## FRUIT CARDS

Fruit Cards do not have special abilities on their own.



**Bananas**  
(set of 12)



**Coconuts**  
(set of 12)



**Pineapples**  
(set of 12)

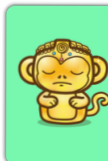
Sometimes a fruit appears with a different colored background to confuse you. Ignore the background and focus only on the fruit. That's what can trigger a SLAP event.



## MONKEY CARDS

**Sneaky Monkeys**  
(set of 20)

The Sneaky Monkeys are the main characters of the game on a blue background.



**Golden Monkey**  
(set of 4)

This is the Golden Monkey Statue on a green background.

## CLARIFYING DOUBTS

- If your final card causes a SLAP event, but you're the last player to SLAP the Discard Pile, do you still win?  
No. You pick up the cards from the Discard Pile and continue playing.
- If two matching fruits appear in a row with different background colors, do I slap the Discard Pile?  
Yes, only the fruits matter. Ignore the background color, it's just there to add more chaos.
- If two Sneaky Monkeys appear in a row, does that cause a SLAP event?  
No, two consecutive Sneaky Monkeys do not cause a SLAP event, only if a Sneaky Monkey appears exactly when 'Monkey FLIP' is said.
- If someone places a card on the Discard Pile after a SLAP event, does it cancel the SLAP event?  
No, the SLAP event is still valid, and everyone must react to it as usual. The player who placed the extra card must take it back.
